Here with us in Osby Figure Skating Club (OKK), a lot has happened that is being planned.

## **Annual Meeting**

On June 23, we had an annual meeting in Ishallen and we had the honor to have Fredrik Granquist from Skåne's Figure Skating Association as meeting chairman. It was quite well attended and there were a lot of discussions where many had to ventilate their opinions.

The big point that was up was that the association is currently without a chairman. This is a fairly large problem as you are practically not an approved association in the eyes of the Swedish Figure Skating Association and this means, among other things, that skiers from OKK are not allowed to participate in competitions organized by associations affiliated to the association.

As a board, we have been appointed by our members to run the association OKK forward, we do not intend to allow our young people in OKK not to have the opportunity to compete.

After we have now worked for a long time on the issue, it is therefore gratifying to be able to inform you all that the board now has a candidate for chairman who is presented / elected at the kickoff according to the annual meeting!

At the annual meeting, most of a board still got together and the new board looks just like this:

## **Economy**

Another point that came up at the annual meeting was that there were some inaccuracies in the results report where training fees had happened to be registered as barbecue accessories instead. The auditors have said that they could still approve the report, but the annual meeting came to the conclusion that the incorrect registrations should be corrected until the kick-off on 6/9.

Now that we have started to look at the finances, we on the board have come to the conclusion that we need to be a little tougher with payments of membership fees and other invoices that are sent out. So we are now developing a new routine on how to handle unpaid invoices.

If you have outstanding invoices from the past season, we will unfortunately not be able to let the children go on at the start of season 20/21. If an installment plan is needed, contact the board.

## **Fees 20/21**

All fees are in total for the entire season, including competition fees, federal fees, skate grinding for our skiers. It is possible to buy a pass.

Membership fee is separately added with SEK 200, for current insurance.
