Inledning - Introduction

Finally we are training again. Last week we had a first network meeting together with all the other associations in the Skåne region. All associations are drawn with exactly the same problem with closed halls and schools. The pandemic issue differs slightly from municipality to municipality, but in general it is quite similar.

Vad har hänt? - What has happend?

We have had digital Off Ice during the closure of the hall, we hope it has been appreciated.

Osby kommun has allowed training again with a maximum number in the entire hall and a maximum number in each changing room. In the ice rink, a maximum of 300 people can stay at the same time, while in the figure skating changing room i can be max 6 people. The association (me) has had to sign a contract where we make sure that we keep ALL restrictions recommended by the public health authority. Should it turn out that we do not follow these, we risk retaliation in the form of not being allowed to use the hall at all. Therefore, ask everyone to help them follow all the rules.

Framtiden - Future

The training is now in full swing and the training times are out on the website. Many have wondered if the Off Ice workouts are canceled, but they are not. We, like all other associations in the local area, will have Off Ice. We understand that these exercises that the children prefer not to have out in the snow, but it is perfectly OK according to the osby kommuns restrictions to conduct these exercises inside the hall. It is important that we comply with all restrictions and keep a distance between hiking during all training sessions. Coaches and the board look at suitable training times, so keep an eye on the website and you will get updated times.

Unfortunately, we are missing some skaters for various reasons. We urge and hope that you are eager to get started with training again. WELCOME WELCOME.

The competitions in the Skåne Figure Skating Federation's (SKF) district are also closed at the moment. It has still been planned that we will start with competitions again in week 11. However, this is a prerequisite for when the Osby kommun have the opportunity to open up the training again. SKF means that our active skaters must have at least 3 weeks of training on ice before they can start competing.

Osby Figure Skating Club was awarded a star competition week 9 which was later canceled. During the spring, we have drawn a winning lottery as SKF has chosen to move this competition to week 14 instead. We can really hope that the restrictions release something and training and competitions can start again.

Åkargruppen - Member Group

We will now open up for the skating school again. This is a challenge for us given the above information on restrictions. In order for us to be able to run a skating school, we need to divide these into at least 2 groups with a little space between the training sessions. We also need to staff up on and around the ice to make sure all parents think about keeping their distance. A schedule for staffing will be posted on the website and set up outside the locker room. Look there for it.

The desire to start selling club clothes has also been on the agenda, but unfortunately we believe that selling / trying / visiting in an infection-proof way will be difficult and have then together chosen to wait with this until the coming season.

Other fun activities are something we want and strive for and once we can do this in a safe way, we do it.

We hope to be able to find a solution as soon as possible so that we can soon start building the strategy and finances for the coming season.
