Introduction

The season is nearly over. What has happened?

April is nearly over and the ice is melted. Spoke with the janitor today and normally it takes around 2 weeks for all the ice and water is gone. To speed up the process, the ice is shaved/planed every day.

Saturday April 10th we hosted a "Slingan" where kids had a chance to perform their routines in front of a crowd without competing. It was fantastic to see so many engaged parents and happy kids at the same time. Everyone was responsible to keep the restrictions we agreed on. It was such a wonderful day. During Easter break on week 14 we continued on with lots of trainings on and off the ice. Great to see so many that participated and made it a good week. We had a parent meeting with Benjamin where everyone got to speak and express their opinion about training times and trainings in general. A very good and rewarding meeting as my feeling is that everyone was satisfied and happy.

On a couple of occasions the board and some parents have sat down and started discussing the strategy for the coming season. There are many good thoughts and ideas that we on the board will include. Naturally, the hope is to arrange for 2-3 times a year and have similar meetings with all the parents and work groups. More thoughts about this in the coming yearly meeting and Kickoff.

Nearly all the invoicing for training cost and sales are out now.

A part of the board has had their second meeting with Region Skåne. Virtually all associations in the Skåne region have had the same worries as we have had in Osby due to the pandemic. Off ice training has started after the ice rink had closed down.

The future

Sport Group

We have previously informed that we are researching the option of renting an ice rink in a nearby town. After discussions with other associations in Skåne it appears we cannot do that. Today (Thursday) all of our ice times in Hässleholm were cancelled. Many associations close their rink at the end of April and some have extended until the end of May.

Very few have ice year round. As we said, it is very sad that we do not have an option for post-season training on the ice. For those of you who usually join the Tyringe camp, it is still uncertain whether it will be possible. Skåne works with Tyringe with the hope of making it happen, but no response has been given so far. We will have to wait and see how Skåne and other municipalities see the future and pre-season. We keep ongoing contact and the next meeting is set for May 18th. We hope to have more information to share with you after the meeting.

Start up for the coming season is planned for week 33. OKK and OIK will have a joint meeting with the janitor and the municipality to set up the time allocations for competitions, tests, matches, etc in the middle of June.

Member Group

We would have like to inform you about something fun at this point. With the current conditions it is unfortunately not possible as the whole country is paralysed by the pandemic. Take care of yourselves and keep your distance, so we can hopefully do more activities together after the summer. We are planning a big clean up of the changing room and other common areas. We would love to have your help. Not everyone can come and clean at the same time, so try to think what would be helpful.

Economy Group

During the spring, we usually spend a lot of time trying to get sponsors for our show. This is a big economic loss for us and we need all the help we can get to bring in funds. The board

He intends on trying out a completely different profession, and currently do not know his availability for after the summer. We on the board have known about this for quite some time and have tried our best to persuade Benjamin to sign a contract for next season but unfortunately failed. Benjamin is well aware of what we think and feel, and we agreed that we must have a definitive answer no later than May 31st. I have also asked him to write a few lines about how he sees the situation:

First I would like to thank all of you for the warm welcome you gave me and for your support during my time here. The season has now came to an end and I will be leaving for the summer. We have tried to plan and try to organize some camps for the summer but unfortunately due to COVID we could not get to any proper planning. About the start of the new season, I still don't know if I will be the coach for next season here in Osby, this has nothing to do with the club, but for personal reasons I don't know If I will be available, but I will try to give the board an answer as soon as possible. At the same time I would like to tell all of you that I had extensive talks with the board and

specifically with Ola, and they have great plans to restore and grow the club in the best way possible, and I really believe that if you will all trust them and the club things will turn out great. I am and will be closely in contact with Ola and I gave him my full availability for any help or advice the club may need even when I will be away. I wish everyone a great summer and hope to see you all soon.

On Monday, the sport group and myself will meet him online again. This potential coach is a guy who is 29 years old. He has skated at the Elite level and represented his country in figure skating. He seems to have a very similar background like Benjamin as a trainer and my personal feeling is that he is as good. We have also had an open dialogue and he knows and understands that Benjamin is our first choice, but we cannot wait until the last minute to decide. We need to make a decision at the end of May or beginning of June. The annual meeting is scheduled for June 6th.
